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



Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapy is an important source of support following amputations. Helping you to restore an optimal level of independence by teaching new techniques and strategies for areas such as personal care and hygiene, meal preparation, using public transport, and accessing community facilities. Most importantly, it is about supporting you to reach your personal functional goals.

Our occupational therapists can also offer expert advice on large items of equipment such as wheelchairs, home modifications, returning to work, and advice about vehicles and adapted driving options.

Physiotherapy

Physiotherapy helps restore movement and function whilst improving flexibility and strength as the body recovers. Sessions will often include putting together a programme of daily exercises to relieve pain and stiffness in joints, ultimately encouraging better movement of the body. Education and advice to improve posture and technique will be covered, and we will continually assess your goals and progression.

Physiotherapists will often be the one to help you use your new prosthesis, assisting in techniques for a comfortable walking gait, and building up the amount of time using a device.







Personal Trainer

Our team of personal trainers develop individual exercise prescription plans for optimum strength and flexibility. Implementing a daily fitness routine will improve your coordination, balance, stamina and agility. Building up the muscle strength in your legs, arms and trunk will help you endure the demands of everyday life, as they play a vital role in how you stand and move.

Setting goals and providing feedback and accountability for your end results will be the motivator behind the sessions, with the aim to not only make you physically fit but to reduce stress and improve overall well-being.

Musculoskeletal Therapy

The musculoskeletal system is made up of our muscles, bones, tendons, ligaments, joints and tissue which work together to move the body and assist with posture. Limb loss often creates a strain on the remaining system, therefore increasing the chance of developing early arthritis and back pain.

Our musculoskeletal treatments include the mobilisation of the joints, acupuncture or soft tissue release therapy, to help alleviate soft tissue discomfort associated with occupational stresses, muscular over-use and many chronic pain conditions.

Psychotherapy and Well-being Support

Mental well-being support is a key component of our holistic rehabilitation program, helping you manage the emotional challenges of limb loss. Delivered by trusted professionals, sessions are private, confidential, and held in a comfortable environment.

These tailored sessions empower you to process your experiences, build resilience, and regain confidence, ensuring your mental health is supported alongside physical recovery. By addressing anxiety, depression, and emotional adjustment, psychotherapy plays a vital role in fostering long-term independence and wellbeina.

Friends and family are more than welcome to visit you here to provide additional physical and mental support. Residential rehab is ideal for those with complex needs, limited home support, or those requiring intensive care.


